

FRED BOLOGNA

Fred Bologna graduated from C. S. U. F. with a Bachelor of Arts in Theater Arts and elementary and secondary teaching credentials. He also studied dance in Fresno, San Francisco, Los Angeles, New York and London. Fred taught elementary school for 11 years and since 1984 he has been a teacher of dance and drama at Roosevelt School of the Arts. He worked with the Fresno Ballet from 1969 until 1992 as a leading dancer and choreographer, and played an important role in the company's leadership, first as associate director and then as Artistic Director. Mr. Bologna is one of the original members of the Good Company Players and since 1974 has served as actor, choreographer, teacher and director. Fred took over as Artistic Director of The New Wrinkles, the annual senior citizen's production produced at Fresno City College in 2003. Traveling around the state, Fred choreographs singing groups from soloists to large choruses. In 1997 he was awarded The Fresno Art's Council's Horizon Award, as educator of the year and in 2000 was a finalist in the Excellence In Teaching Awards from the Fresno Public Education Fund. Fred has served as a board member for the Meux Home Museum and has been board president for the Fresno Ballet, Fresno Arts Council and the local chapter of The National Society of Arts and Letters.
